

Success Analysis Protocol *

Purpose: To analyze and celebrate successful practices.

Roles: A timekeeper/a facilitator

Steps:

- Reflect on and write a short description of your greatest success this year. Note what it is about the event/practice that made it so successful. (3 minutes)
- In groups of 4, the first person shares their greatest success and why it is so successful. (2 minutes)
- The group of 4 discusses how this event/practice is different than other teaching practices. (2 minutes)
- Each of the other three members of the group shares their greatest success and why it is so successful, followed by a group discussion analyzing how these practices differ from other practices. (Each round should take 3-4 minutes)
- The small group discusses what was learned by the analysis and what the implications are for other events/practices within their work area. (5 minutes)
