
# Be the Cardinal You Can Be Proud Of

# What does PBS do for YOU?

- Students get intervention to help them refocus their unsuccessful behaviors.
- Interventions include:
  - Advisory
  - Tutoring
  - Conferences
  - Interventionist support
  - Counselors
  - Administrator supports

# What is CARDINAL CASH?


- Cardinal Cash is a way to reward students who show the 4 PBS Core Values at Raytown South:

The Cardinal Cafe lets students buy things like granola bars, gum, school supplies, and spirit items.






# **Cardinal Café**
