
Big-5 Generator


- School is unit of analysis
- Provides summary data
 - How often
 - What
 - When
 - Where
- Easy to use

Data Collection Tool


- School, grade, class and individuals are units of analysis
- Provides summary data
- Able to drill down
- Similar to SWIS, but less expensive (free)
- Better data for decision making
- More data to enter
- As mom used to say, there is more to break
- Does not track multi-year data


