- Many behavior problems are a mismatch between task and the student's skills.

Adjust task to meet student ability

- Length of assignment or the time allotted
- Mode the task is to be completed (choice)
- Increase instruction or practice provided
- Additional support (buddy, instructional tips, calculator, written steps)
