- 66 Tornadoes touched down across 7 states.
- F3 tornado struck Caruthersville
- Over 600 homes destroyed
- 1/3 of town wiped out
- 2 fatalities
- High School & Middle School attended the elementary for the remainder of the school year.
- HS Students in FEMA trailers until Feb. 2011.






ODR's Since Implementation
