An environment created to meet the student needs on all levels. Helping to meet their basic needs along with academic and social/emotional support .



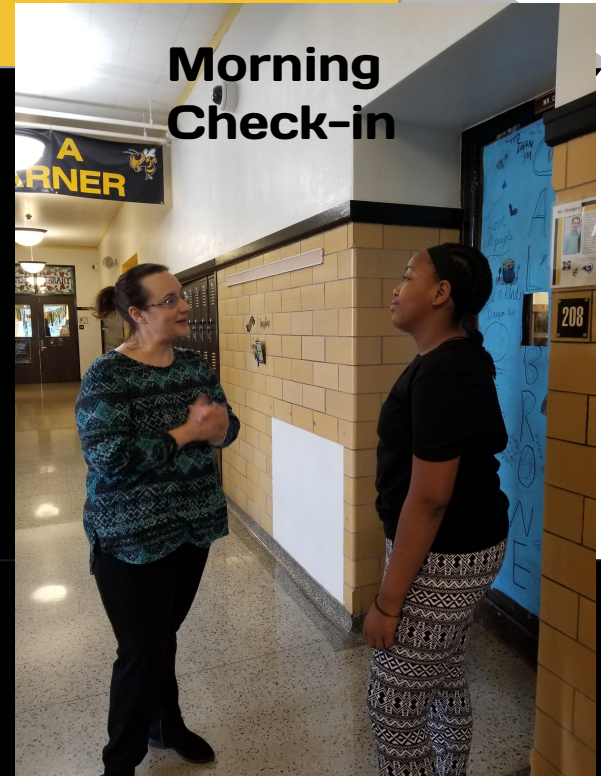

Check In Check Out

Check In Check Out is a daily intervention that matches a student with a mentor from within the school building. The student and adult check in with each other in the morning to discuss goals for the day, and to assess how the student is feeling about the day. The mentor may provide a paper copy of the Check In sheet, or there may be an electronic sheet. The student is responsible for reminding teachers to complete their portion of the sheet at the end of each class period. At the end of the day the mentor and student meet again to go over the daily sheet, and process through successes and areas of growth from the day.



This can be especially helpful to build relationships with students. Students who are seeking connections with an adult or mentor benefit from this program.

Challenges can arise when students do not feel a connection with their mentors, or do not take responsibility for their sheets.
