



MO SW-PBS 2020/2021 Submission Data Schedule

The purpose of MO SW-PBS data submission and School of Excellence Awards have always been to encourage best practice and to ensure schools have the data that they need to make decisions that benefit students. The 2020/2021 school year is shaping up to be one of uncertainty and new challenges. While SW-PBS Systems, Data, and Practices can help schools meet these challenges, we expect school staff to be extremely stressed as they plan how they will address these challenges. We are, therefore, modifying expectations for data collection and MO SW-PBS Award of Excellence Data Criteria for the 2020/2021 school year.

2020/2021 DATA EXPECTATIONS

Data	2020/2021 Expectation	Rationale
DBDM/Solution Plan Or Team Meeting Minutes and Big-5 Report	Criteria: Submit four times during the school year. Deadline: Any time before April 15, 2021	New rules and procedures will be required regardless of whether schools meet face to face, or virtually. These will take time to get in place. At the same time, DBDM/Solution Planning is critical for problem solving around student behavior, attendance, engagement, and academic benefit.
School Climate Survey (SCS) or School Safety Survey (SSS) Taken online at PBISApps or other validated school climate survey.	Criteria: 80% of students complete in the Spring of the year. Window: January 25-March 31	For many students, school is the only safe and predictable place they have. The SCS monitors the extent to which schools are providing this safe and predictable environment for students.
Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI) Taken online by the leadership team for each tier of implementation at PBISApps	Complete once annually; Take the scales relevant to the tiers at which you are training or implementing; >70% in place on the Tier 1 Scale Window: January 25-March 31	The TFI is a fidelity assessment that measures the extent to which schools have systems of support in place for all students. Furthermore, because it is only taken by the leadership team or the tiered leadership teams, it provides a great deal of actionable information for relatively little effort.
Student Intervention Outcome Data (Tiers 2 and 3, only) Submit to Tier 2 and Tier 3 Consultants	Criteria: Includes the number of students enrolled in targeted or intensive interventions, the number who responded positively, the number who graduated, and the number who require additional supports Deadline: April 15, 2021	Schools that earn Silver or Gold Awards must be providing targeted and intensive interventions, and must monitor the effectiveness of these interventions.

Data	2020/2021 Expectation	Rationale
School Safety Survey (SSS)	<i>Optional</i> on request; may be taken in lieu of the SCS	While it is arguable that risk and safety factors may be even more important during the pandemic, it is believed that this survey should not be an expectation for 2020-2021.
Self-Assessment Survey (SAS)	<i>Optional</i> on request	The SAS provides important information regarding staff perceptions of whether systems and practices of SW-PBS are in place. However, the TFI also provides implementation fidelity data. Furthermore, it may be a challenge for staff to take the SAS if teaching virtually.

Applicants will be asked to provide supporting documentation. These supporting documents should include one or more of the MO SW-PBS artifacts.	Schools will need to modify their matrices, lessons, recognition system, majors and minors lists and definitions, etc., depending on the requirements of the setting in which you hold school this year. We encourage you to submit these artifacts to your regional consultant for feedback, but this will not be an expectation.
