#### Just Right, Just in Time Support

Teachers frequently express the need for support in using effective instructional and classroom management practices. This need has intensified as teachers adapt to providing online instruction. Recently, there has been a surge of interest in adapting existing systems or creating new systems for providing just right, just in time support for all teachers through professional learning opportunities. #### Identify Expected Practices

- What procedures are currently in place for staff to receive performance feedback (data collection and sharing)?
- What adaptations need to be made for online instructional environments?
- How will you communicate performance feedback procedures with staff?

#### Provide Professional Learning Opportunities

- What professional learning opportunities do you already have in place to support implementation of expected practices?
- What resources do you need to find or develop?
- How will staff access resources?

#### Facilitate Access to Supports

- How will staff select resources to match individual need?
- What criteria would indicate supports should be offered to staff, individually or as a whole?
