

## Feedback Video Checklist

Type of Feedback	Definition and Examples	Document strategies observed in video
Specific Positive Feedback	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verbal or gestural response to expected behavior</li> <li>• <b>Specifically states</b> the observed behavior</li> </ul> <p>Examples:            You were being <b>safe</b> by keeping your hands to yourself.            Tommy, great job of completing your assignment that is being <b>responsible</b>.</p>	
Non-Specific Positive Feedback	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verbal or gestural response to expected behavior</li> <li>• <b>Does not specifically</b> state the behavior observed</li> </ul> <p>Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Good Job</li> <li>• Way to go</li> </ul>	
Specific Corrective Feedback	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verbal or gestural response to a behavior error</li> <li>• <b>Specifically states</b> what the expected behavior should be</li> </ul> <p>Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Proximal Praise or Control</li> <li>• Redirect</li> <li>• Reteach</li> <li>• Provide Choice</li> <li>• Conference</li> </ul>	
Non-Specific Corrective Feedback	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verbal or gestural response to a behavior error</li> <li>• Punitive in nature</li> <li>• <b>Does not specifically</b> include a component to teach the expected behavior</li> </ul> <p>Examples:            Sit down            Stop talking            SHHHHHH!</p>
