Help...I have students struggling with behaviors!

Remember to DOCUMENT the interventions you have tried and your parent communication. This will be necessary information if the child needs to be referred to Tier 2.

• Weekly PLCs

- Tier 2 Data and interventions
- Focus on Math, Reading, PBIS
- Tier 3 Data Meetings every 6 Weeks
 - Include all necessary stakeholders
- Work with specialists for interventions and advice
 - o ELL
 - Reading Specialists
 - Special Education teachers
- <u>Track Intervention Data</u>

Once a student is nominated:



A meeting will be scheduled for the next Tier 2 Meeting:

<u>ANY</u> teacher with a nominated student:

- All teachers who work with the nominated student need to come to the student's nomination meeting.
- Meetings will always be on Tuesday mornings (2nd and 4th) please keep these mornings available in case your student is called for a meeting.
- Help the classroom teacher complete the Tier 2 nomination form

What Options Do We Have?

Academic

- Plan for more intervention
 - Document, Document, Document!
- Recommend for special education referral
- Realize student is learning and progressing and pat ourselves on the back :)



- Put tier 2 intervention in place (if not already)
 - Check in/ Check Out
 - Social Skills
 - Check and Connect
- Continue Interventions
 - Document, Document, Document!
 - Consider making goal more rigorous if goals are being met but the intervention is still needed
- Recommend for special education referral

We've Made a Decision...Now What

Academic

- Schedule a follow up meeting for 6 weeks after the initial meeting
- Use the data collected from interventions to make a decision or continue with another round of interventions
- Repeat the process

> Behavior

- Schedule a follow up meeting for 6 weeks after the initial meeting
- Check on how students are doing with their Tier 2 interventions
- Use the data collected to determine if Tier 2 is needed
- Repeat the process
