Our PAC is comprised of a representative sampling of students demographically as well as behaviorally













SENSE OF BELONGING





Actual post from a 5th grade teacher during one of our feeder pattern breakfasts. Relationships and sense of belonging matter!




MODELING

We model, consistently, what we want our staff to do. When students try sprinting down the hallway, for example, we use the language "Walking feet, please." This reminds staff to be positive in tone while reminding students of the expectation. When that doesn't work, we get creative....
