- Bingo
 - o This can be a session or everyone together with prizes!

- J-Cafe

 - Students work in pairs. They go "hunt" for something stuck up in the halls.
 They can only bring one back at a time.
- Outside time / Gaga Ball / Field time
- STEM challenges / Escape Rooms
