The purpose of MO SW-PBS data submission and School of Excellence Awards are to encourage best practice and to ensure schools have the data that they need to make decisions that benefit students.

Data	2024/2025 Expectation	Rationale
DBDM/Solution Plan or Monitoring Meeting	Criteria: Submit at least one per quarter. Due: Oct 18, Jan 10, Mar 21, May 30	Schools that regularly use office discipline referral (ODR) data to plan schoolwide interventions improve school climate and behavioral outcomes for students.
Climate Survey: Complete the School Climate Survey (SCS) online at PBISApps or a District Selected Climate Survey	Criteria: ≥ 80% of students eligible stakeholders complete a climate survey Window: Jan 27 – Mar 31	The SCS monitors the extent to which schools are providing safe, inviting and predictable learning environment for students.
Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI) Taken online by the leadership team at PBISApps for each tier that school is training at or implementing	Criteria: ≥70% in place on the Tier 1 Scale; Complete at least once annually in Spring, and once in the fall when beginning training Tier. (Tier 1 Recognition applicants must have an external walkthrough & facilitation) Window: Aug 1 – Sep 29 (Baseline, 1 st year training at a Tier) Jan 27 – Mar 31 (Annual; All MO SW-PBS Schools)	The TFI is a fidelity assessment that measures <i>leadership team perceptions</i> of the extent to which SW-PBS systems and practices are in place at all three tiers of support. Data from this survey is used to improve implementation.
Self-Assessment Survey (SAS) Taken online at PBISApps by entire staff.	Criteria: ≥80% of staff complete in the Spring of the year; ≥70% on the Schoolwide and Classroom Scales. Window: Jan 27 – Mar 31	The SAS provides important information regarding <i>staff perceptions</i> of whether systems and practices of SW-PBS are in place.
Student Outcome Data (SOD) download Completed using a link that is emailed to team members in May	Criteria: Student outcomes related to assistance referrals and ODRs, disaggregated by grade level and disability status. Window: May 1 – June 30	In order to monitor whether SW-PBS is having the desired impact, schools need to monitor student outcomes .
MO SW-PBS Artifacts (Tier 1) download Matrix, Tier 1 Implementation Improvement Plan, Lessons, Teaching Schedule, Recognition System, Unexpected Behavior definitions, & Flowchart	Criteria: Submit all required artifacts; score 100% on the Tier 1 Artifact Scoring Guide Single Point Rubric Due: April 15 (submit throughout the year for feedback) Note: Once an artifact has met criteria, you need not resubmit it in subsequent years	Tier 1 Artifacts provide evidence that SW-PBS systems are in place.
Tier 2 Action Plan (Any Action Plan format)	Criteria: Must be current; must address Tier 2 content Due: April 15	Schools review Tier 2 data annually and revise action plan in order to engage in cycles of continuous improvement.
Advanced Tiers Development Checklist	Criteria: All criteria are in place	Schools implement evidence-based tiered interventions with fidelity.
Tier 2 and Tier 3 Intervention Outcomes	Criteria: Includes # enrolled each intervention, # who graduated, and # requiring more intensive support Due: April 15	Tiered interventions provide support to all students who will benefit, and fade support from students who no longer require them.
Tier 3 Action Plan (Any Action Plan format)	Criteria: Must be current; must address Tier 3 content Due: April 15	Schools review Tier 3 data annually and revise action plan in order to engage in cycles of continuous improvement.
Functional Behavior Assessment/Behavior Intervention Plan for a student (name redacted)	Criteria: ≥80% with no “0’s” on the FBA/BIP Rubric Due: April 15 (submit throughout the year for feedback)	Schools implement evidence-based tiered interventions with fidelity.
