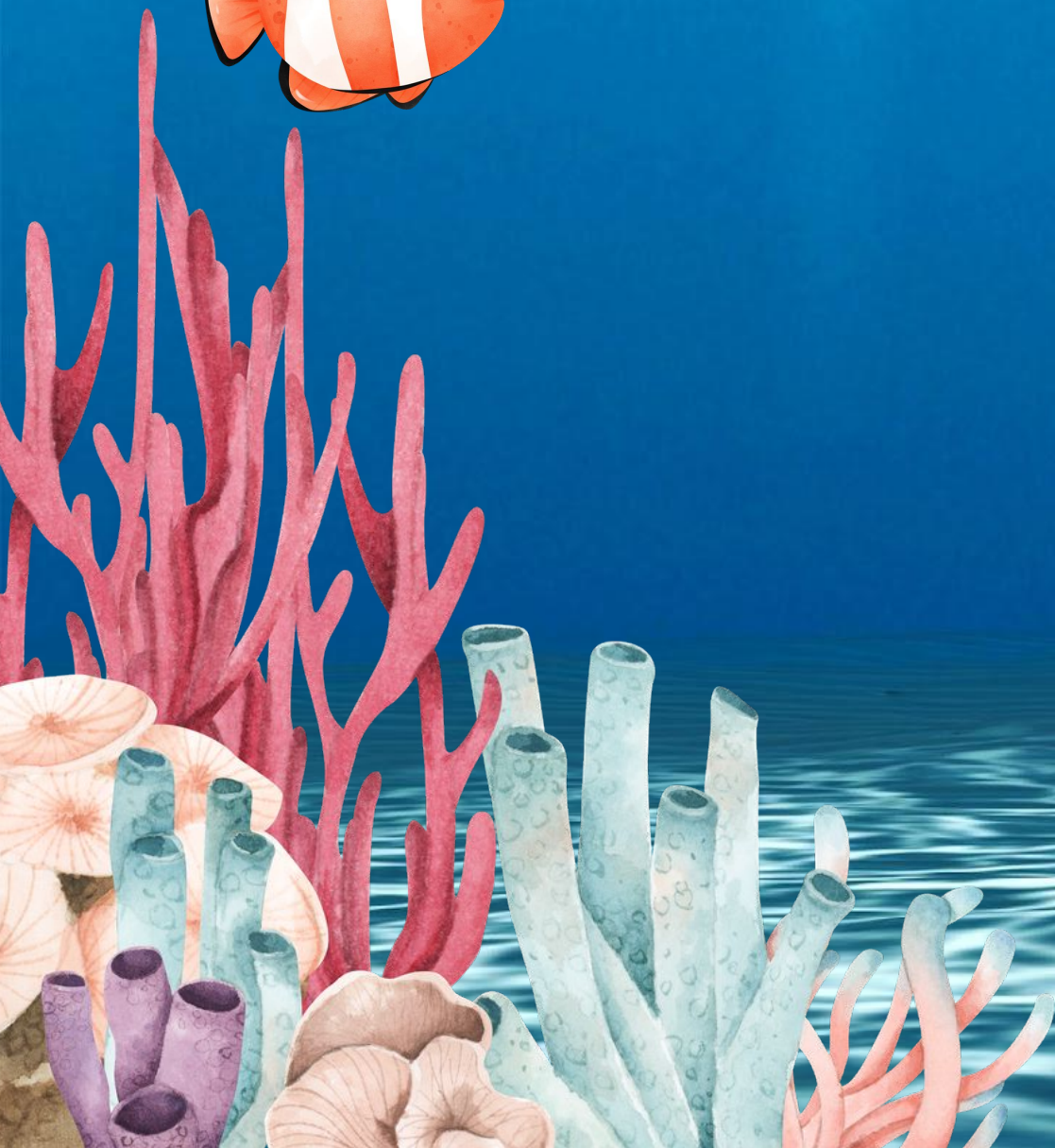
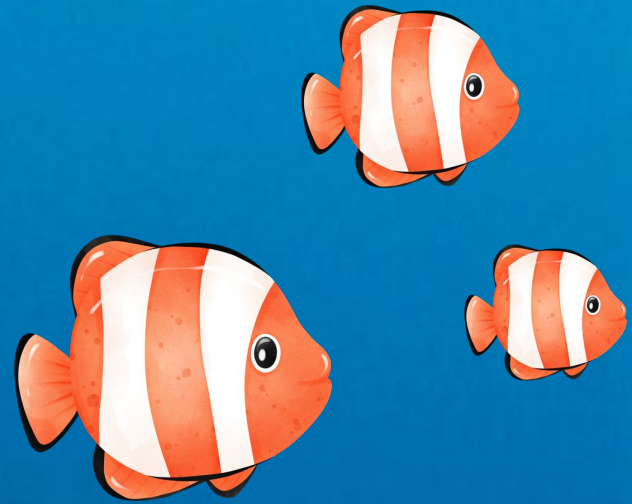

TICKETS

Tickets are given to individual students for following the Big 3

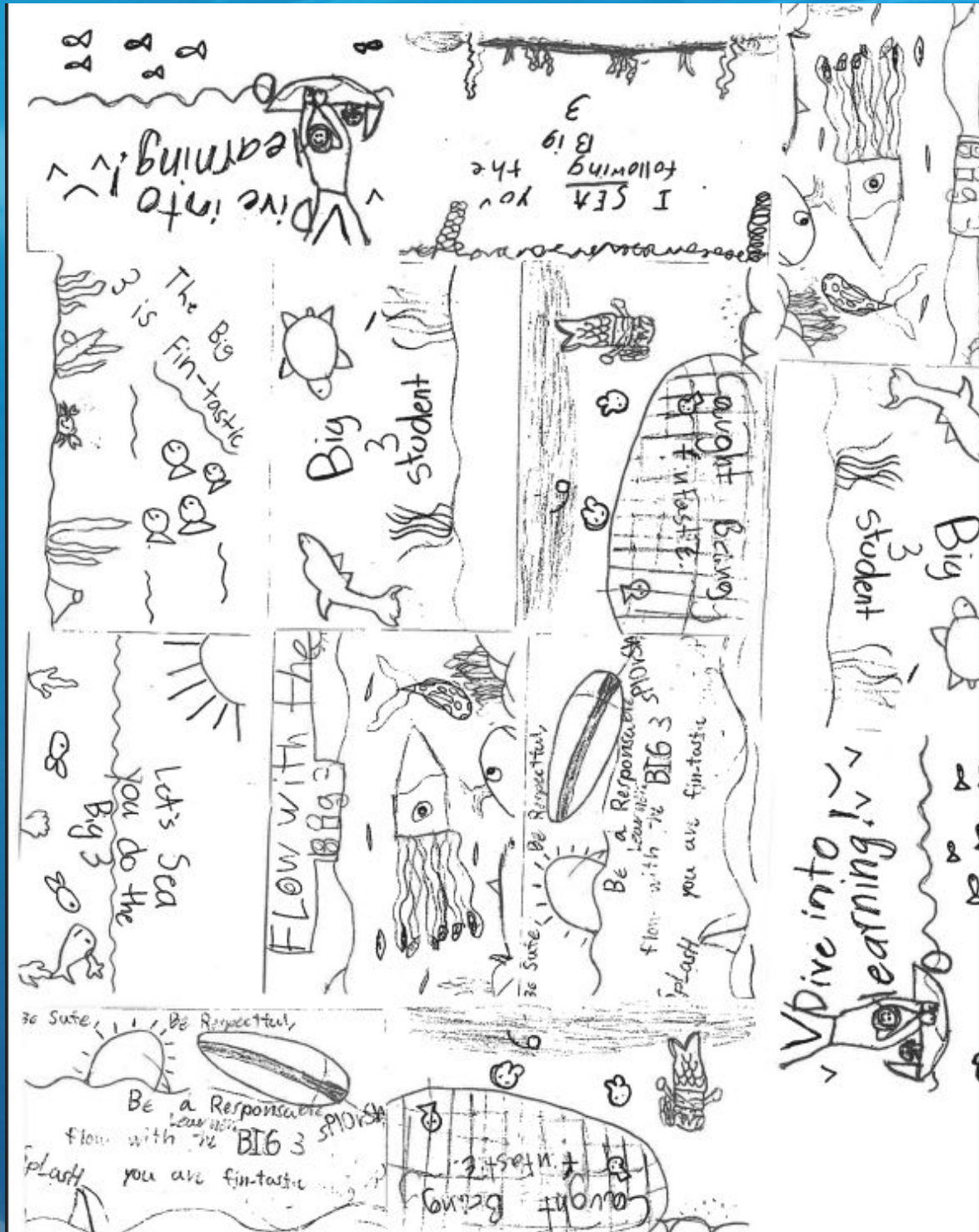
- (Be Safe, Be Respectful, Be a Responsible Learner)

- Each teacher sets the way that tickets are collected

- some have a pencil case bag, small box, etc.

- Student input

- 3rd grade class gets to design for next year



CLASS INCENTIVES

When Students get 10 tickets they are able to “buy” a designated reward in their individual classrooms

- Reward certificate

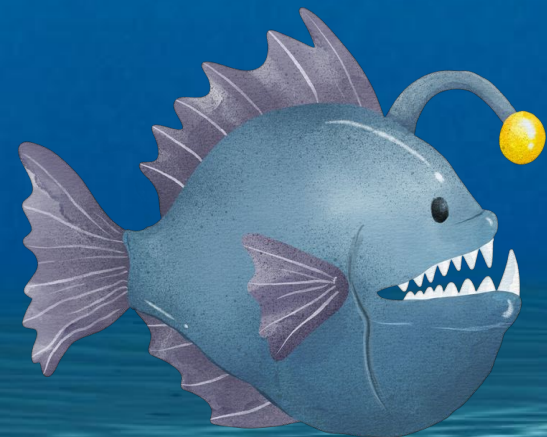
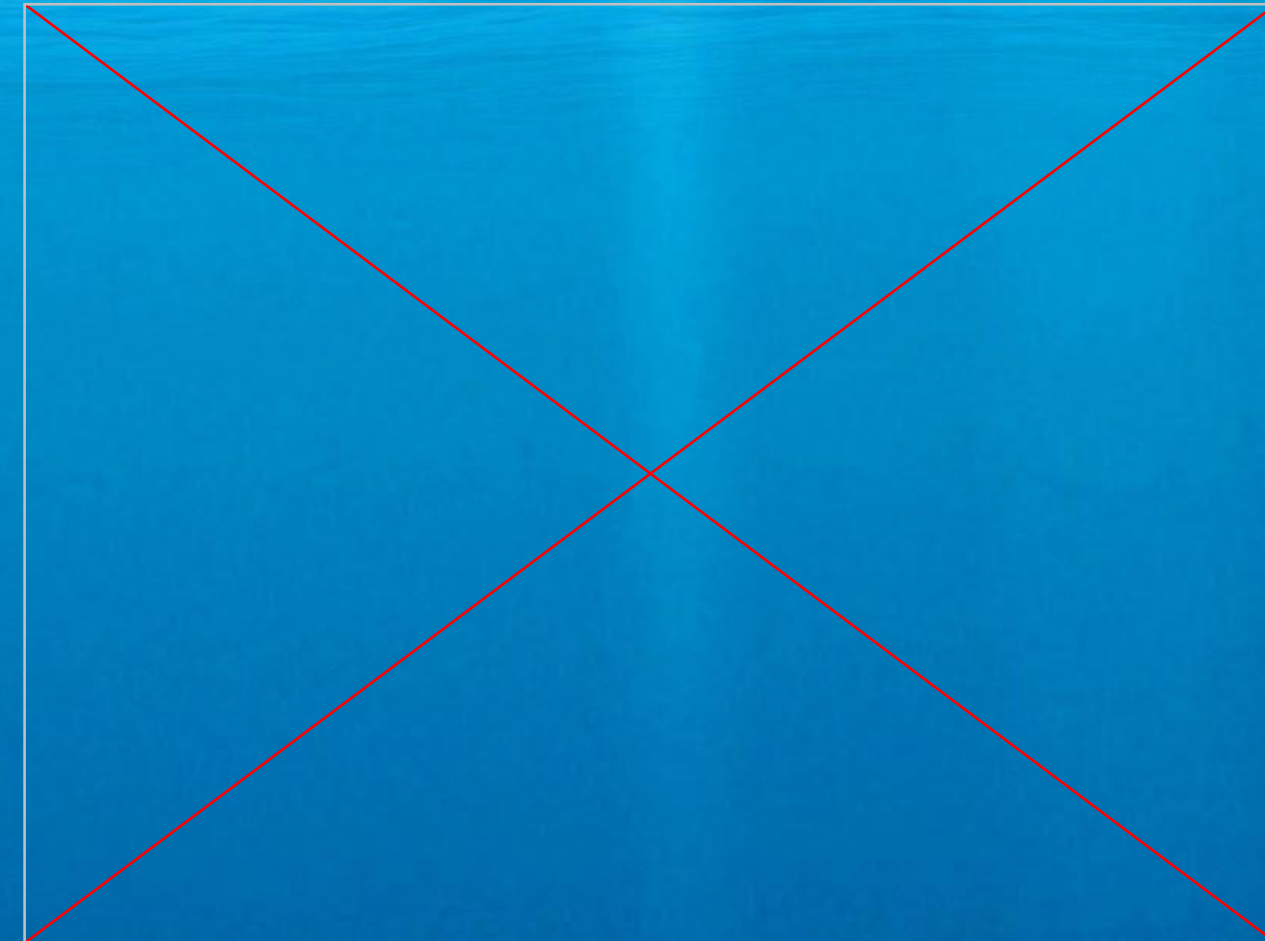
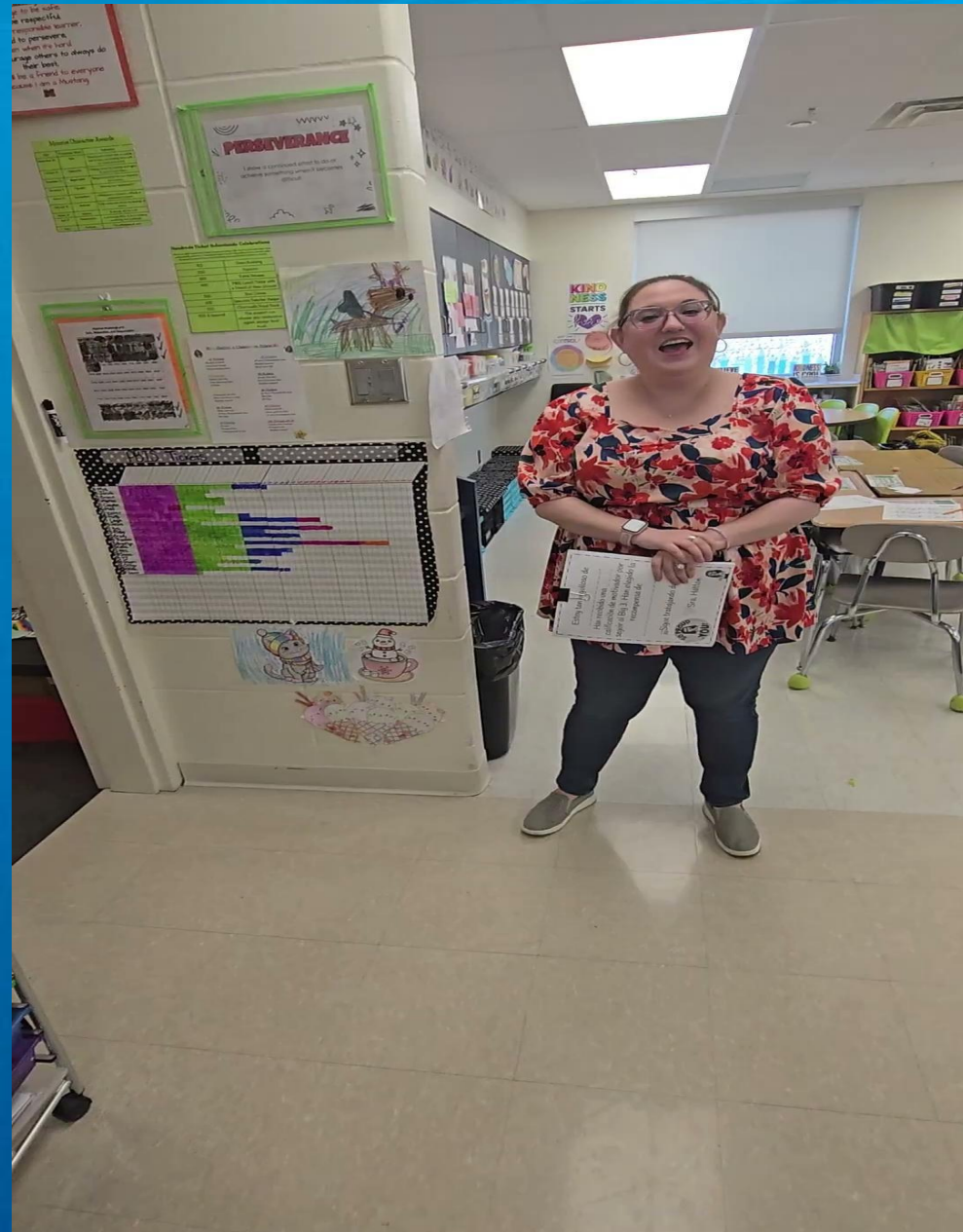


CLASS INCENTIVES CONT.

- Special shoutout in announcements



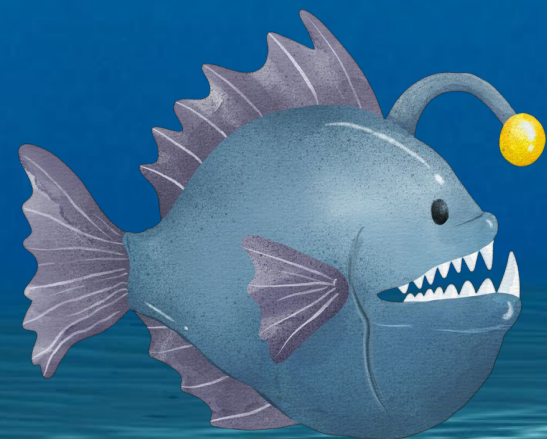

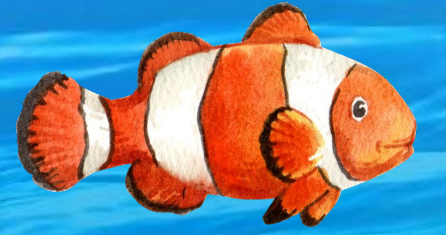

Each time a class gets to 100 they take off of the school bingo board

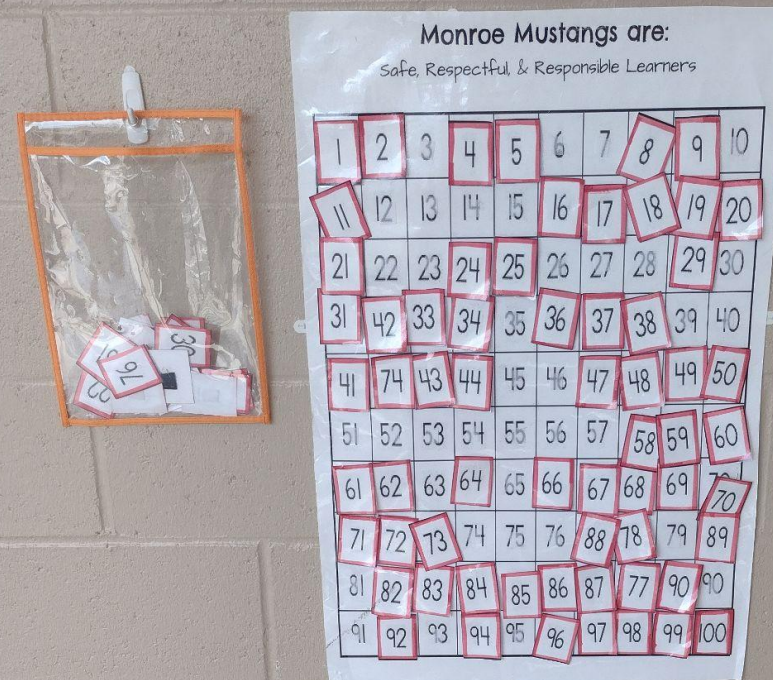
Have also used: poster and hidden picture behind the numbers, virtual slide

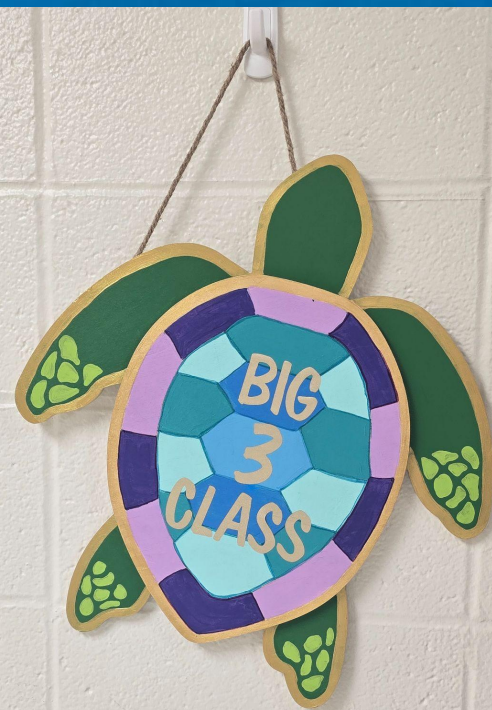
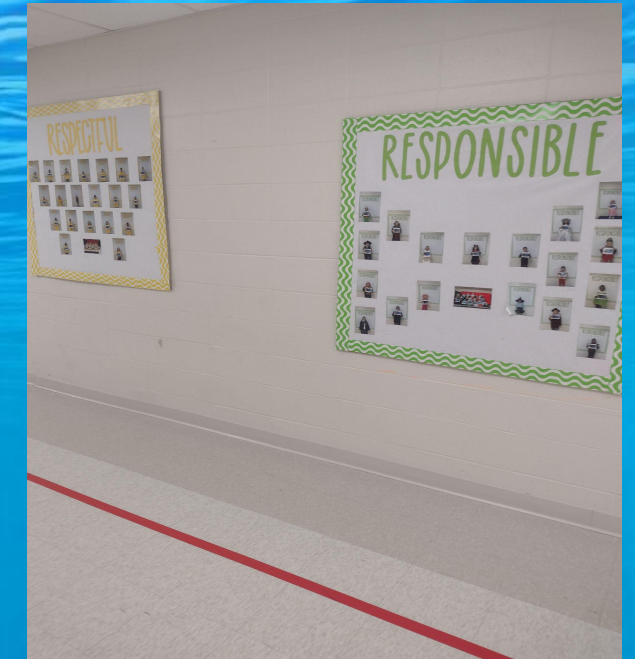
Monroe Mustangs are SAFE, RESPECTFUL,



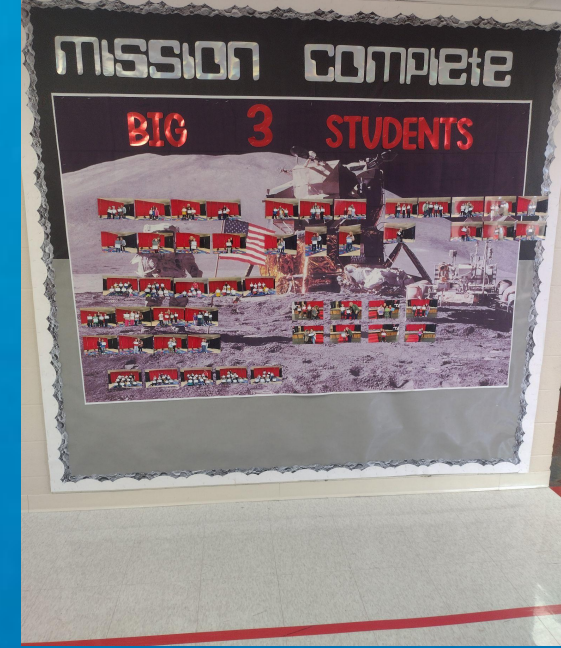
